Remembrance Day Friday 11th November 2016 To the Memory of the Fallen and the Future of the Living

Remembrance Sunday, which falls on 13th November 2016, is a day for the nation to remember and honour those who have sacrificed themselves to secure and protect our freedom. Remembrance is part of modern British life, culture and heritage. The two minute silence, held each year at the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month, marks the end of the First World War.
