## Summer School 2021

Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted to inform you that this summer we will be running a Summer School programme for students who will be in **Years 7-11 for the 2021-22 Academic Year**.

For our Year 7's joining us in September, this is an additional opportunity to become more familiar with the college and fellow students.

We are supporting a national initiative that has been introduced by the Department of Education. Through Summer School we aim to offer a programme of enrichment activities, some of which students have not been able to experience this year.

The focus of the project will be to improve physical and mental health while engaging students in fun activities that help them to develop relationships with their peers. The days will be centred around enrichment activities such as team games, drama, art, science, catering and IT. We will also focus on embedding key English and Maths skills to help consolidate learning. All sessions will be delivered by fully qualified staff. On the final day for each year group, there will be a celebration and rewards.

We believe that this programme can have a positive impact on our students. Please see below the dates that we will be hosting activities for specific year groups:

Year 9	4 <sup>th</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> August
Year 10	4 <sup>th</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> August

The programme is free of charge and the college will provide a cold packed lunch for all students on each day. The day will run from 9.00am and finish at 2.30pm. Students should wear sports/active wear.

We have places for 150 students from each year group and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
