We are looking forward to welcoming your son/daughter to Wright Robinson in September.

Therefore, the following events are cancelled:

We would like to assure you that we take the transition process from Year 6 into Year 7 seriously and we are working hard under the circumstances to ensure that the process is as smooth as we can make it for your son/daughter. Our Transition Co-ordinator is in the process of visiting primary schools to ensure that we have all the necessary information about your son/daughter for their start in September. We will be sending transition activities and virtual sessions to all our primary schools for completion during Transition Week and we will be adding further information to the Transition area of our website in the coming weeks.

### Summer School

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all families who have signed up for a place for the Year 6 Summer School that we are holding on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021.

We have had an excellent response, which is really encouraging. Due to the cancellation of Induction Days, may I strongly suggest that if you have not signed your son/daughter up for a place that you do so. This will give students a chance to meet teachers and their peers and become familiar with the building before they start in September. This will also help with the move from primary to secondary school and hopefully, relieve any worries that students may be feeling.
