Will I have a chance to visit Wright Robinson before we start in September?

In normal circumstances we would run two graduation days in July to get you into college, to familiarise yourself with the buildings and meet staff. We are currently planning to run a transition event for you. However, this will be dependent on further government advice regarding Covid-19. More details will follow.

What will happen if I cannot visit before September?

As mentioned above we will endeavour to get you into college during our graduation days in July. However, if this is not possible, we will ensure that in September you are able to come into school and have a transition day to help you settle in. There will also be a virtual tour and a video message on our website from our current year 7's to help welcome you.
